

BBOY/BGIRL SCHOLARSHIP

OBJECTIVE

To present bboys and bgirls in university an one time \$1000 scholarship towards expanding his/her education.

WHY?

Our community needs more educated bboys and bgirls. We need to expand our culture and diversify the types of professions that bboys and bgirls attain. This will increase resources for the bboy and bgirl communities and help move the culture forward.

ELIGIBILITY

- Minimum of 2.50 Cumulative Unweighted GPA / Overall GPA (for international conversion: <http://www.foreigncredits.com/Resources/GPA-Calculator/>)
- Students are enrolled in college or university for the Spring Semester of 2013.
- Must attend any accredited university, community college, junior college, and vocational school. International schools are included!

(Unfortunately, only students enrolled in secondary education can apply. No high school students, sorry!)

REQUIREMENTS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Any college bboy or bgirl can apply, but we are looking for **FOUR KEY COMPONENTS** that will determine the winner.

#1: recent college transcript. (unofficial transcripts are fine)

#2: Class Schedule for Winter 2013 (if you are on a quarter system) or current Spring class schedule if you're on a semester system.

#3: Present a video displaying your dance skills. Being the "best" bboy or bgirl will **NOT** factor in determining the winner, but we do need to see how serious you are about dance. The video must have been filmed & posted within the past 6 months. Please use an online, video-sharing website: Youtube, Vimeo, etc.

#4: Present us with a 500 word essay (in English), **choosing from one of two topics:**

1. Think of a personal experience in which bboying influenced academics or academics influenced bboying. How was your experience enriched by this interaction?
2. Hip Hop is a very popular and thriving culture around the world. The influences of Hip Hop can be seen in many different communities internationally. In your words, describe the effects of the globalization of Hip Hop and what can be done to incorporate the Hip Hop culture and Bboy culture into higher education curriculum.
